


Mr. & Mrs. Champagne

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Materials:

- Wool (Sport Weight), e. g. Schachenmayr Catania/Scheepjes Catona
- Crochet hook in suitable size (for me: 2.0 mm)
- 4 eyes (for me: 10 mm) - you can also embroider or crochet the eyes
- Some thin black yarn for the face
- Stuffing
- optional: some cardboard or plastic to put into the bottom for more stability

Abbreviations (US Terms):

MR = magic ring

inc = increase

sc = single crochet

dec = decrease

ch = chain

BLO = back loop only

slst = slip stitch

FLO = front loop only

st = stitch

(-) x = repeat inside of () for x nr of times

Crochet in continuous rounds (spirals), unless otherwise stated.

Bottom:

Off white, creme or light beige

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (sc 4, inc) x6 (36)
7. (sc 5, inc) x6 (42)
8. (sc 6, inc) x6 (48)

Fasten off invisibly.

Optional for more stability: cut out a round disc of cardboard or plastic in size of the bottom to put it in later.

Glass:

Beige

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (sc 4, inc) x6 (36) < - you can also cut out a round disc of cardboard or plastic in this size to keep the top flat while stuffing.

Color change to off white, creme or light beige

7. **FLO:** sc in each st around (36)
- 8.-10. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (36)
11. **BLO:** (sc 11, inc) x3 (39)
12. **BLO:** sc in each st around (39)
13. (sc 12, inc) x3 (42)
- 14.-15. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (42)

Color change to beige again.

16. sc in each st around (42)
- Fold down the edge of the glass (see picture).*

17. (sc 13, inc) x3 (45)
- 18.-22. (5 Rounds) sc in each st around (45)
23. (sc 14, inc) x3 (48)
- 24.-33. (10 Rounds) sc in each st around (48)

Put in the disc for the top here, if you made one and stuff the upper part.

34. (sc 6, dec) x6 (42)
35. (sc 5, dec) x6 (36)
36. (sc 4, dec) x6 (30)
37. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)

Color change to off white, creme or light beige

- 38.-39. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
40. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
41. sc in each st around (18)

Stuff the glass.

42. (sc 4, dec) x3 (15)
- 43.-57. (15 Rounds) sc in each st around (15)
58. (sc 4, inc) x3 (18)



59. sc in each st around (18)

Stuff the stem tight, so the glass can stand well. You may add some wire or wooden stick for more stability if necessary.

60. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)

61. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)

62. (sc 4, inc) x6 (36)

63. (sc 5, inc) x6 (42)

64. (sc 6, inc) x6 (48)

Finish stuffing the stem, put the disc for the bottom in and crochet the previously made bottom part together with the glass with a round of sc (the bottom faces you while crocheting).

When you've finished this round, fasten off invisibly.



Bow tie / bow:

Crochet in rows. At the end of each row, chain 1 and turn.

1. ch 10, ch 1, turn (10)

2.-6. (5 Rows) sc in each st around, ch 1, turn (10)

7. sc in each st around (10)

Fasten off invisibly.

Thread a long thread of the same color through a needle and insert the needle in the middle of crochet piece as shown in the photo. Tighten the thread and wind the rest of the thread around the middle, leaving some thread to sew on. Secure the thread end and sew to the glass with the remaining thread.



Finally attach or embroider the eyes and embroider the face.

Of course you can create more accessories. For example, you could put on a veil and a top hat and you would have a nice present for a bridal couple. There are many possible uses.
